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ADMISSION TO CLASS – V (ACADEMIC SESSION – 2027)

REVISED NOTIFICATION

Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith, Purulia, established in 1957, is a branch centre of the Ramakrishna Mission, founded by Swami Vivekananda. Affiliated with the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education and the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education, it is a fully residential school for boys, offering education in both English and Bengali medium from Classes V to XII.

The Vidyapith welcomes boys from all sections of society, irrespective of caste, creed, or religion. Guardians who appreciate the educational ideals of Swami Vivekananda, as embodied in the Ramakrishna Mission's system of education that emphasizes the harmonious development of body, mind, and spirit through character building, academic excellence, self-discipline, and values-based learning, are encouraged to consider admitting their wards to the Vidyapith.

The admission process for Class V consists of three stages: a Written Test, an Interview, and a Medical Examination. These are designed to assess not only the candidates' academic aptitude but also their personal qualities, overall potential, and suitability for the Vidyapith's fully residential environment.

1. Eligibility:

- a) Qualification : Boys who are studying in Class IV/V and have obtained a minimum aggregate of 60% marks in the last Annual Examination they appeared for are eligible to take the admission test. In cases where the school follows a grading system instead of awarding marks, the exact percentage equivalent to the grading scale and the conversion formula used must be mentioned. Documentary evidence may be required to validate the grading scale and conversion formula, if necessary.
- b) Age limit : Boys born between 1 September 2015 and 30 April 2017 (both dates inclusive).
- c) Height : 130 cm to 152 cm
- d) Weight : 30 kg to 50 kg

2. Application Procedure:

- a) The Application Forms will be available online on the official website www.rkmvp.org from **20.07.2026, 11:00 a.m. to 28.11.2026, 05:00 p.m.** No offline Application Form will be issued.
- b) During the online application process, the following documents must be uploaded:
 - i. Birth Certificate of the student
 - ii. Aadhaar Card or Aadhaar Acknowledgement
 - iii. Caste Certificate, if applicable
 - iv. Marksheet of the student's most recent Annual Examination (Candidates studying in **Class IV** must upload the **Class III** Annual Examination marksheet, while candidates studying in **Class V** must upload the **Class IV** Annual Examination marksheet)
 - v. Recent passport-size photograph
 - vi. Signatures of the student and guardian
- c) The Admission Test fee of Rs. 1,300/- (Rs. 2,200/- for candidates from Manipur) must be paid online on or before **28.11.2026, 05:00 p.m.**

- d) Once the Application Form has been successfully submitted and the Admission Test fee has been paid, the **Admit Card** can be downloaded and printed immediately from the website. If a printout has not been taken, open the Application Form link, click **Login**, enter the candidate's **Application Form No.** and **Date of Birth**, and print the Admit Card. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall without the Admit Card.

d) Interview, Medical Test & Admission : **15.12.2026 and 16.12.2026, from 09:00 a.m.**

b) Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandira (Autonomous), Belur Math, Howrah
c) Ramakrishna Mission Institute of Culture, Golpark, Kolkata
d) Ramakrishna Mission, Sahudangi, Siliguri, Jalpaiguri
e) Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith, Purulia
f) Ramakrishna Mission, Imphal, Manipur

N.B.: The Shikshanamandir (B.Ed. College), Vidyamandira, Golpark, and Siliguri centres have limited seats available and operate on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the form fill-up is completed, requests for a change of admission centre will not be entertained.

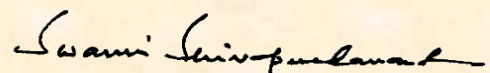
5. Subjects of the Written Test & Interview:

- a) First Language - Bengali/Hindi (Marks – 50) c) Mathematics (Marks - 50)
b) Second Language - English (Marks - 50) d) General Intelligence (Marks - 10)

6. During the interview process for admission, the following documents are to be submitted:

- a) Original copy of Character Certificate issued by the Headmaster/Principal of the applicant's present school
b) Medical Certificate issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner, mentioning his/her Registration Number
c) Photocopies of the Annual Income Certificate(s) of the guardian(s)
d) Two copies of passport-size colour photographs of the applicant

7. Any information furnished in the Application Form that is subsequently found to be incorrect or false may lead to the cancellation of the candidate's candidature or, if already admitted, expulsion from Vidyapith.
8. Candidates must report to the examination venue at least 30 minutes before the examination starts.
9. The student shall use a ball pen (blue or black) to write the answer papers.
10. Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing calculators, mobile phones, Bluetooth devices, or any other electrical gadgets in the examination hall.
11. Communication of any sort between the examinees inside the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited. If a candidate writes his name or puts any special marks at any place in the Examination Booklet, which may disclose in any way the identity of the candidate, he shall render himself liable to be disqualified.
12. Vidyapith offers scholarships to students in need of financial assistance based on merit and good conduct.
13. Vidyapith does not offer any coaching or tutorials specifically for the Admission Test. The institution does not provide question papers from previous years or sample question papers for preparation purposes.
14. No accommodation within the Vidyapith campus will be provided during the admission tests.
